ORIGINAL TASMANIAN DEVIL
13.5 grams - 1/2 oz

The "Tassie Devil" is the original of the three sizes that are manufactured in Australia by Wigstons Lures. Performance as a trolling, casting, downrigging or jigging lures is best described as a great all-rounder. Best trolling speed is 4.5 KPH (2.75 MPH) and the correct speed is indicated by a pulsing or nodding action of the rod tip. Centre inserts are CT2 - treble hook and CS2 - single hook.

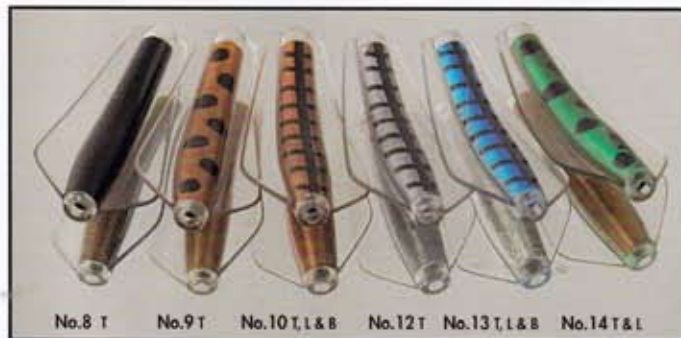
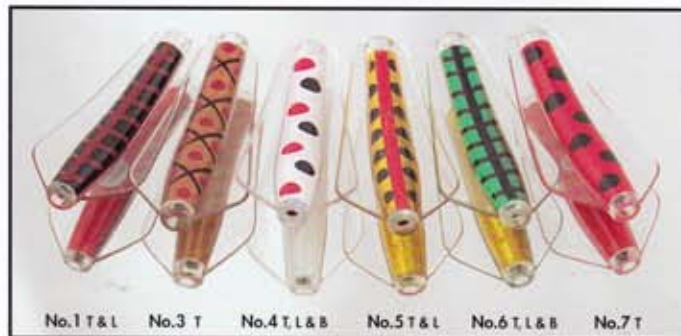


LITTLE TASMANIAN DEVIL
7 grams - 1/4 oz

This lure is ideal for casting in small rivers and streams. A recommended trolling speed 4 KPH (2.4 MPH) is sufficient to provide the unique action of flicking and swaying from side to side that normally will attract the most reluctant fish to strike. When casting, vary the retrieve by flicking the rod tip. Centre inserts CT1-treble hook and CS1-single hook.

BIG TASMANIAN DEVIL
26 grams - 1 oz

The "Big Tassie Devil" is designed for bigger fish and performs ideally as a trolling, downrigging or jigging lure. Recommended trolling speed is 5.5 KPH (3.5 MPH) and the correct speed can be monitored by rod pulse. Downriggers or lead core can be used to increase trolling depth. Centre inserts are CT3 - treble hook and CS3 - single hook.

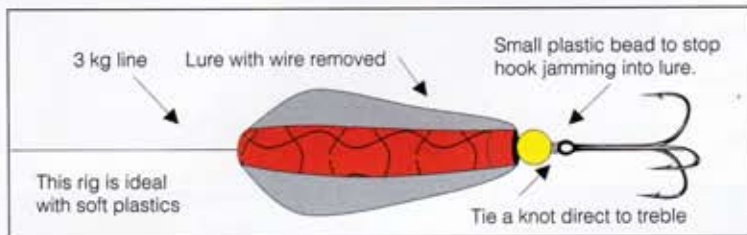
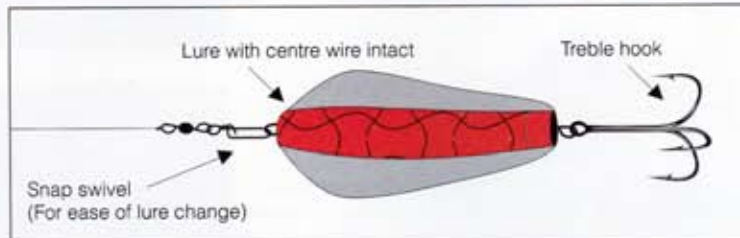
How to fish with TASMANIAN DEVIL® Fishing Lures

"They bite like the Devil"



STANDARD RIG:

The fishing line may be tied directly to the eye of the stainless steel insert or clipped on using a snap swivel to enable quick and easy lure changes.

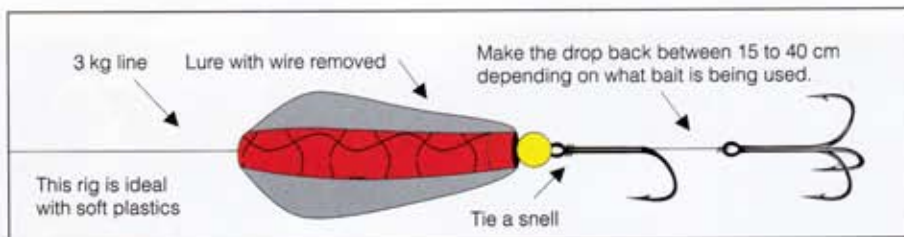
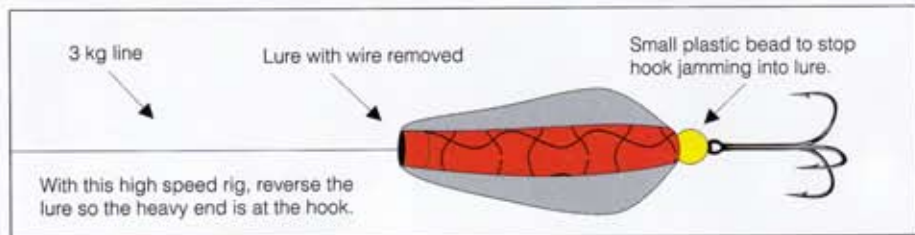


ALTERNATIVE RIG:

With this rig the lure is free to run up and down the line. when the fish jumps out of the water, the weight of the lure will not provide a lever to dislodge the hook.

HIGH SPEED RIG:

With this high speed rig the lure is reversed so that the heavy end is near the hook. This combination will run at a faster speed without looping.

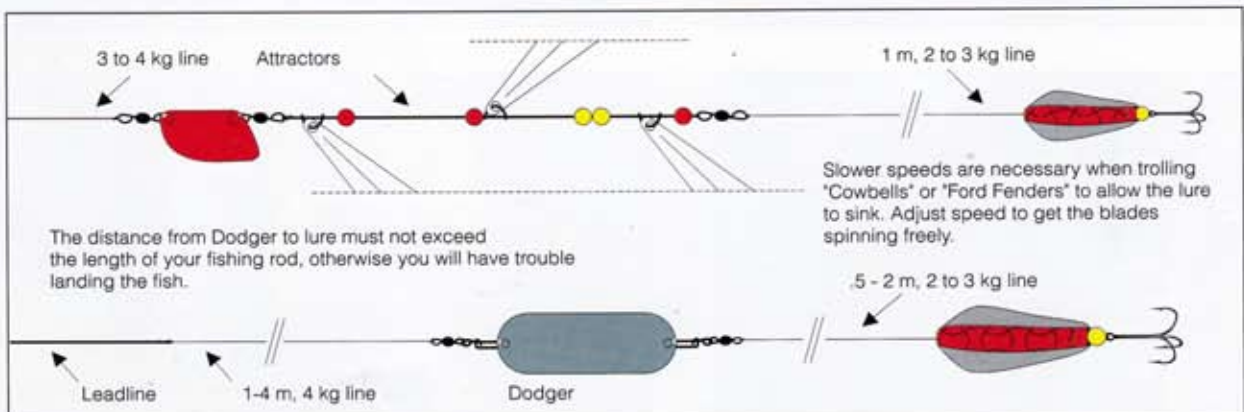


STINGER RIG:

Developed in the USA for short takes. This rig is ideal with soft plastic baits.

OTHER ATTRACTOR RIGS:

When trolling attractors, slower speeds are necessary to allow the "Tassie Devil" to sink



Slower speeds are necessary when trolling "Cowbells" or "Ford Fenders" to allow the lure to sink. Adjust speed to get the blades spinning freely.

.5 - 2 m, 2 to 3 kg line
